CATTEWATER HARBOUR COMMISSIONERS **SCHEDULE OF HARBOUR RATES & DUES ON** **VESSELS & CARGOES OF EVERY DESCRIPTION**

effective 1st April 2017

Pier and Harbour Order (Cattewater) Confirmation Act, 1950
The Harbours Act, 1964

The following harbour dues will be applicable from 00:01 on 1st April 2017

Note: Rates and dues for yachts and other small craft using the harbour are published separately

EXEMPTION

All vessels entering or leaving Sutton Harbour or the Millbay Docks at Plymouth and not anchoring in or using the Cattewater Harbour for any longer time than three days immediately before entering or leaving Sutton Harbour or Millbay Docks and not using the moorings or works of the Commissioners and not leaving the Cattewater Harbour during such three days except to go into Sutton Harbour or the Millbay Docks and also all cargoes of such vessels unless shipped or unshipped in Cattewater Harbour shall be exempt rates under this Schedule.

PART I : HARBOUR DUES ON VESSELS USING OR ENTERING THE HARBOUR

Rate 1

On every vessel entering the harbour for the purpose of laying by, bunkering, taking on stores or executing repairs and remaining no more than 7 days and not loading or discharging cargo, per gross registered ton

9.50p

Rate 2

Every vessel to which Rate 1 is applicable shall if remaining more than one week pay in addition for each week or part thereof per gross registered ton

18.95p

Rate 3

On every vessel discharging or loading cargo within the harbour per gross registered ton

18.95p

Rate 4

Every vessel to which Rate 3 is applicable shall if remaining more than one month pay in addition for each week or part thereof after the first month, per gross registered ton

18.95p

Rate 5

Every vessel loading in the harbour after discharging to pay half rates in addition to the ordinary inward rate 9.50p

Rate 6

Minimum charge on any vessel £48.25

PART II : CARGO DUES ON GOODS SHIPPED OR UNSHIPED WITHIN THE HARBOUR**Rate 7**

For fish, including shellfish, crabs etc. brought into and landed within the harbour or to any place within the limits of the harbour by sea, on the gross proceeds of the market value. £0.025/£

Rate 8

For dredged spoil per metric tonne 8.80p

Rate 9

For all other merchandise, goods, articles and things per metric tonne 13.40p

Rate 10

Project cargoes Rate on request

PART III : PASSENGER DUES**Rate 11**

For passengers landing in the Cattewater from visiting passenger ships £3.50 / head

Charges

- (1) The charges specified in this list shall be payable in respect of services used on and after 0001 BST on 1st April 2017.
- (2) All charges are net 60 days. However, if charges incurred are not paid within that period of time the following increases shall be payable.

<u>Period after charges become due</u>	<u>Percentage Increase</u>
Payment after 2 months but not exceeding 3 months:	5%
Payment after 3 months but not exceeding 4 months:	10%
Payment after 4 months but not exceeding 5 months:	15%
Payment after 5 months but not exceeding 6 months:	20%
Payment after 6 months	30%
